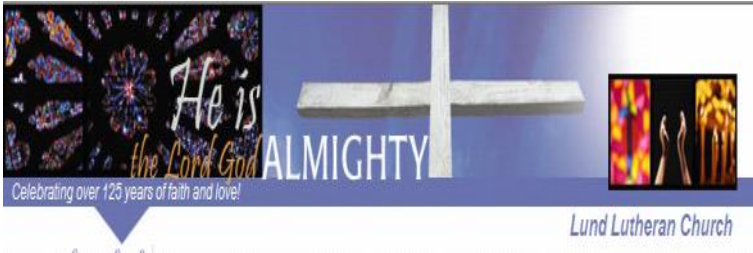

- *2017-2018 Budget: Discussion followed. Motion to approve as written. Judy/Myra/carried.

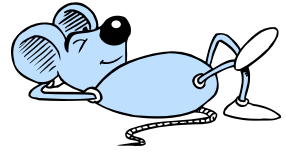
Next meeting : August 9th with Lynda doing devotions. Closed with prayer.

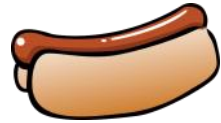
