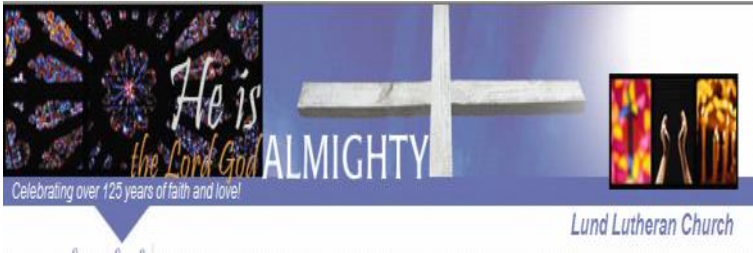

Ahoy There, Mates!

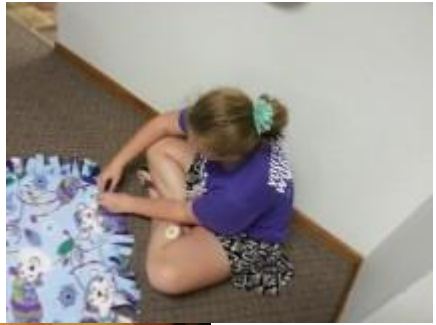

The Difference

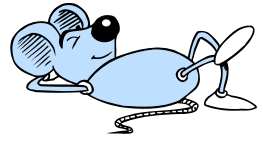
I got up early one morning and rushed right into the day;

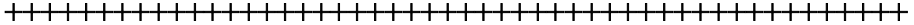
**Hospice of the Red River Valley is looking for

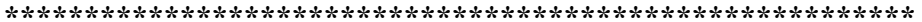
