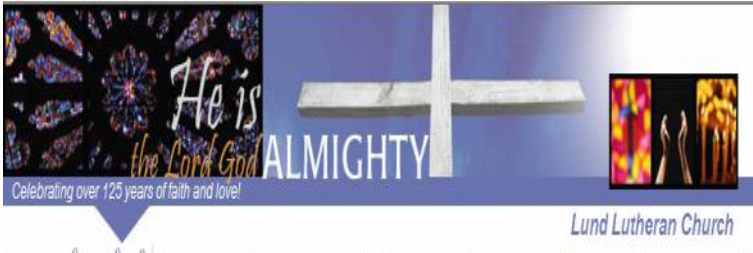

Pastor's Message for June

May the God who gives endurance and encouragement give you the same attitude of mind toward each other that Christ Jesus had, so that with one mind and one voice you may glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Romans 15:5-6 NIV

There is uniqueness to what we experience on Sunday mornings for an hour. It would be rare today to find another place where people join together to sing, do responsive reading aloud in unison, and stand up in the middle of the event and move about greeting one another. We give prominence to the readings from a book written centuries ago. We proclaim in unison our statement of agreement, our creed. We celebrate that someone gave his life for us and remember it by observing a meal consisting of a thin wafer and a thimble of wine--Strange indeed by any measure of modern society.

But in and through this special hour we are encouraged and renewed to run with endurance the path of life we journey. It is not by the rituals and practiced repetition that lifts us up, although we may find comfort in the familiarity.

Our true endurance and encouragement comes from being together in fellowship with the One who calls us to that hour. We meet for a divine appointment. We meet God in and through His Word and in the Sacrament. We have our minds renewed in the same attitude of our Savior towards us and drawn again in love into the unity He desires that we express in oneness of mind and voice, glorifying God our Father.

This oneness, this unity in Christ is not broken when we leave the sanctuary doors. We continue in that oneness as we stretch out into the community bringing glory to the Lord in the work place, the school, the home kitchen, the coffee shop, the clothing store, and wherever we go. We do not go to these places alone; we go with the presence of God in us!

This is what God calls us to by grace through faith in Him. As we grasp the reality of the true relationship God offers to us as forgiven, redeemed and chosen for His holy, eternal purpose, we begin to understand King David's expression "the Joy of his salvation." Our hearts seek that unity in Him and with fellow believers. We want to share that joy with others who have yet to know it. We have our perspective expanded to see the entire realm of our existence that stretches from here to eternity. We see God, not as some answer to prayer to get something only temporal, we see Him as a Person to love, a person to share our life's best and worst moments, one who is always and forever closer than a brother.

On Sunday before the service begins, take a moment and reflect on your I.D. as a follower of Jesus. Remember who you are in Christ. Look up and smile at your heavenly Father with a greeting from your lips to his ears. Then look around at those gathered with you. Aren't you glad we can join together to sing, pray, and worship God?

Meeting closed with prayer by Pastor Jim Osvold.

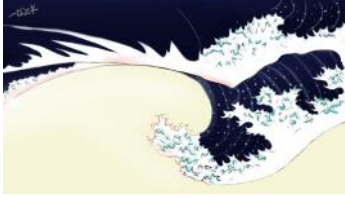

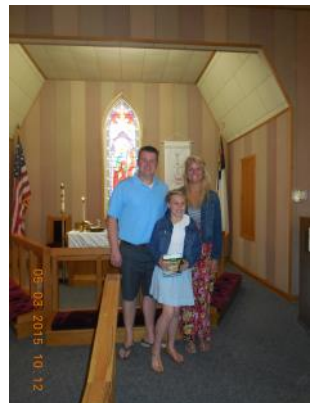
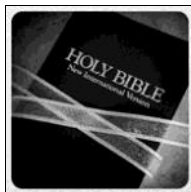

The Youth finished out their Youth & Discussion Nights with a bowling party on Wednesday, May 3rd.

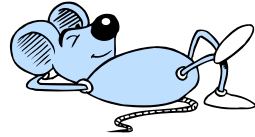

job of presenting it.**

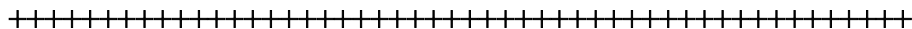
**This weekend is Memorial weekend where we remember

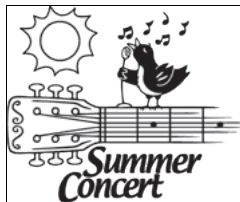
