

#### Philippians 4:5-7 (NIV)

<sup>5</sup> Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near. <sup>6</sup> Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. <sup>7</sup> And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

I have a friend who serves as a pastor in a neighboring town. When I asked what's on his plate of things to do in his ministry, he replied, "Preach, pray, and plug away..." I smiled because I know his life is full with a very active congregation. Yet, I think he summed up the essence of what it means to place our dependence on God's grace and power in meeting the challenges of life's needs. We hear the Word of God through bible study and proclamation, we bring our every need to the Father in prayer, and then we proceed in whatever lies before us in confidence that He will direct our steps. When I am reminded of the promises of God, His correctives in how I should live, and I lay my burdens at His feet in prayer, then there is a sense of peace that comes that transcends my ability to understand.

When I was a child, I had all the confidence in the world that my dad knew how to operate the car when we piled in to go somewhere. I didn't understand how the car worked except for the noise of the engine and my dad stepping on pedals and moving the steering wheel. But Dad directed that hunk of steel down the road and I enjoyed the ride. I was safe in his care. My confidence was in Dad's love for me.

When Jesus lived among us in his earthly ministry, he preached and did many miracles, but time and again he went to a quiet place to

pray. Because He is God, He didn't HAVE to pray: He wanted to pray. He desired to bring everything into complete harmony with the Father and Holy Spirit. He taught us the foundation of prayer in "Our Father who art in Heaven...." Our confidence is in the Father's love.

The bible is filled with the words "pray, prayer, praying, Lord hear us, Lord answer us, and thanks for answered prayer." We have a great gift that we can exercise anytime, anyplace, and any situation. And the Lord carries us safely along. We may not side step the bumps in the road, but the Lord will carry us through.

May 1<sup>st</sup> is designated National Day of Prayer. Thousands of people everywhere will pray. But we don't have to wait for a special day to get the Word, Pray, and plug away. That is every day. Believers in the resurrected Christ are invited into the throne room of God Almighty where we enter in confidence. God has spoken and His Word is true. He hears our petitions and receives them. He directs our steps and we proclaim His Glory. Get and give the Word, Pray, and plug away!

Motion/Sec. Russell O./Les H. to proceed with the installation of an upgraded sound system at an estimated cost of \$6500.00. Passed.


Motion/Sec. Russell O./Donna H. to replace/upgrade lighting in the Foyer due to a fire hazard and safety issue. Passed.


